2. Many have tried to reject His commands for salvation.
3. There are three very good reasons we must keep in mind when we are decided whether or not to obey the words of Jesus:
 - a. John 16:15; 12:48: The words of Jesus and the words of God are one and the same. This being true, they will be the standard by which we will be judged on the last day. If we do not obey His commands then nothing can save us.
 - b. Acts 2:38: We know Jesus meant for His commands to be kept, for we have many examples in the book of Acts where His faithful disciples carried out His commands. Do we want to be His faithful disciples or not?
 - c. John 14:15: If we have any love at all for God and for His Son, then we will obey the command of Jesus. Do you love the Lord?
